# The Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

- Recognized nationally and internationally as one of the foremost Women's and Gender Studies departments in the United States
- Over 200 majors and minors
- All courses consider complex interactions between race, ethnicity, locality, class, gender, and sexuality

# The Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

The Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies major:

- 36 credits (18 required, 18 electives)
- Internship opportunities
- Honors Research Seminar
- Advanced undergraduate students have presented their research at state and national student conferences
- Careers in the non-profit sector, government organizations, corporate sector, etc.

# The Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

Four **minors** in WGSS and one **online certificate**

- **Women's, Gender, and Sexuality minor** (18 credit hours). WGSS minors have completed majors in a variety of disciplines, from biology to history and from economics to journalism
- **Critical Sexualities Minor**: pioneering thinking on sex, sexuality, hierarchy, intellectual activism, and social justice

# The Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

- **Social Justice Minor:** students are encouraged to understand the complexity of social justice and become familiar with various social justice practices
- **Gender and Media Minor:** perspectives on the representation and production of gender in the media; students acquire **critical thinking** skills and **technical skills** as media producers

# The Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

- **Online certificate in Women's Global Health Leadership**, developed in collaboration with the Institute for Women's Leadership and National Nurses United. Students take courses such as Global Women's Health Movements and Impacts of Economic Inequality on Women's Health

# The Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

## **New BA / MA Track in Feminist Practices for Social Change**

- Students complete **both a BA and an MA degree in WGSS in five years**
- Students can complete up to **three graduate courses at undergraduate tuition** rates
- **Study abroad** opportunities, assistance for entrance into the job market
